# Elementary Summary

- All grade levels, except 3<sup>rd</sup>, increased the percent of student meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in Reading
- All grade levels increased the percent of student meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in Writing by more than 9%
- Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade levels increased the percent of student meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in Math
- All grade levels increased the percent of student meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in Science
- All grade levels, except 5<sup>th</sup>, increased the percent of student meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in Social Studies
- Increase in the percentage of Kindergarten students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 7 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 1<sup>st</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 7 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 6 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 5 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 4<sup>th</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 6 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 5 out of 9 content areas
- Increase in the percentage of 6<sup>th</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade level expectations in 7 out of 9 content areas
- 7% decrease in the percentage of students with perfect attendance
- 4% increase in the percentage of students with 95% attendance or better
- More students are falling below the 80% attendance rate
- 3.2% increase in the percentage of students receiving one or more discipline referrals

# Middle-level Summary

- 4% Decrease in the percentage of students passing by subject and courses in 7th and 8th grade
- 48% of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students passing all courses
- 52% of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders failing one or more courses
- 6% decrease in the percentage of students with 90% or better attendance
- 3% increase in the students falling below 80% attendance
- 4% increase in the percentage of students receiving one or more discipline referrals

# High School Summary

- Increase in the percentage of students passing by subject in 10 out of 16 the subjects (1%)
- 1% increase in the percentage of students passing all courses (40%)
- 1% Increase in the percentage of students failing one or more courses (60%)
- No change in the percentage of students with 90% or better attendance (17%)
- More students are falling below the 80% attendance (20% of high school students)
- 3 % decrease in the percentage of students receiving one to five discipline referrals

- Inconsistency in grading practices
- Inconsistency in instructional expectations
- More teachers are grading according to CCLS standards and expectations
- Increase in instructional rigor
- Students struggle at all levels to attend school regularly

# Initiatives for School Improvement

- By the end of the school year, all schools will have completed the Diagnostic Tool for School Effectiveness.
- Grading Committee has developed a draft grading process to ensure consistency across all grade levels. A draft will be presented to the superintendent for review and approval.
- Interim Assessments aligned to the CCLS have been developed and implemented.
- Greater focus on using data to inform instruction, including data protocols and action plans.
- At-risk Reports prepared quarterly by building, teacher and student.
