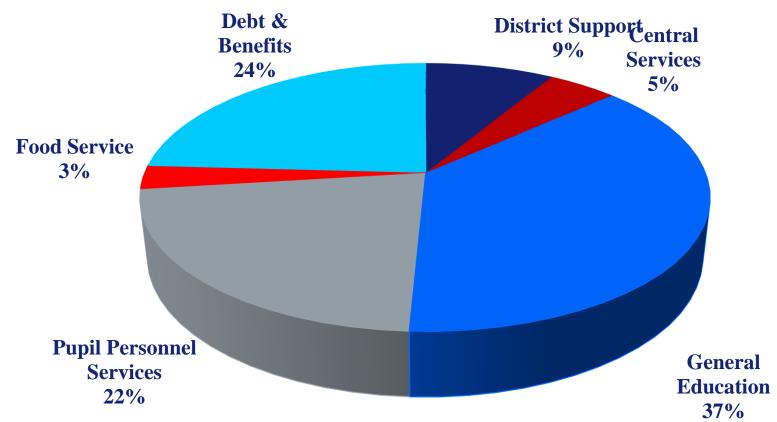

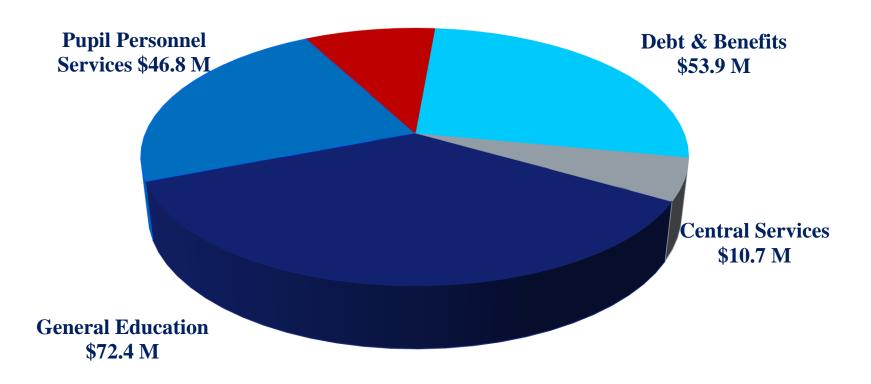

## 2019-20 GENERAL FUND \$202.4 MILLION

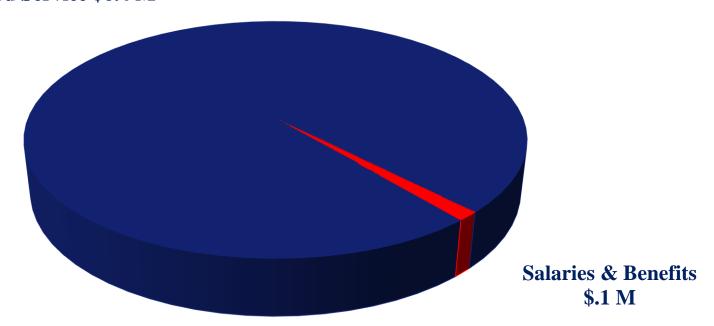

# FOOD SERVICE FUND \$6.5 M

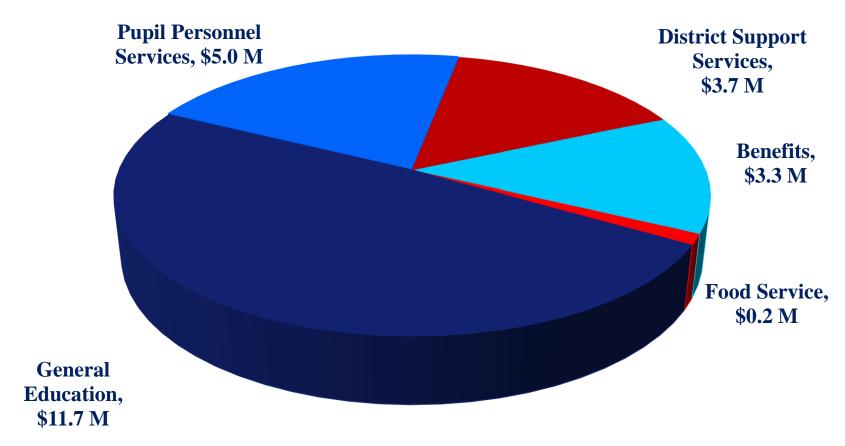


## Food Service \$6.4 M

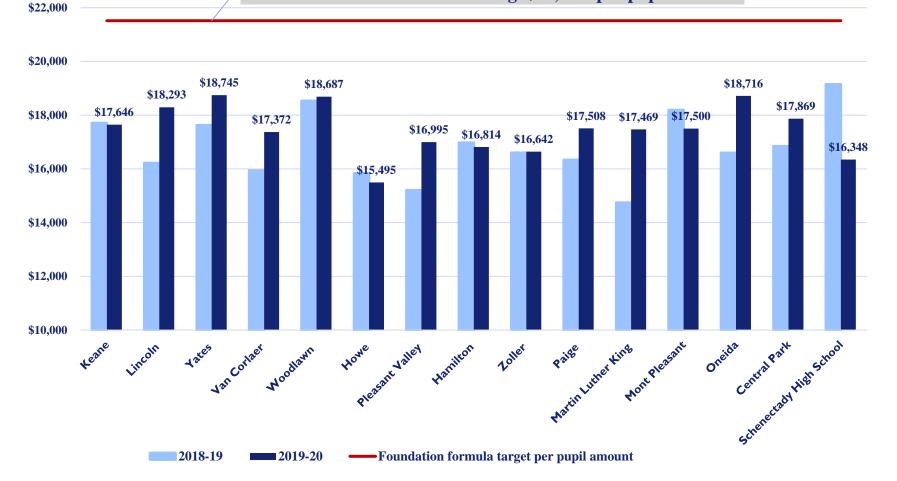
