

## Decrease Elementary Class Sizes

- Several studies have shown that reducing class size increases overall student achievement, especially for younger, disadvantaged children.
- While space constraints may prove problematic, similar impact can be experienced utilizing a co-teacher model
- The following are some of the benefits of fewer students in a classroom:
  - Students receive more individualized attention
  - Smaller class sizes can lead to higher achievement and narrowing the opportunity gap
  - Allows the teacher greater proximity to students and more opportunities for one-to-one and small-group instruction
  - Students in smaller classes tend to perform better in all subjects and on all assessments when compared to peers in larger classes
